When you enter the staging area, you will need a **PRINTED COPY OF YOUR PAID RECIPT WITH THE BAR CODE**. This receipt serves to gain your vehicle entry and also you and one guest in lieu of separate General Admission tickets.

SPECTATOR PARKING:
